Questions to Consider When Hiring Your Own Personal Care Attendants

- 1. Tell me about yourself.
- 2. Tell me your expectations for this job.
- 3. How far away do you live from my house?
- 4. What means of transportation will you have to my house?
- 5. How do you feel about providing intimate/personal care (i.e., bladder and bowel care, bathing)?
- 6. (If applicable) How would you feel about serving me alcohol or lighting my cigarettes?
- 7. How do you feel about working overtime when necessary?
- 8. What are your expectations for vacation days, sick time and comp time?
- 9. Do you mind working some holidays (i.e., Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day)? Are there specific holidays that you can not work?
- 10. Tell me about your past personal care attendant work experience(s).
- 10a. What did you (not) like about the job(s)?
- 10b.Did you work as a personal care attendant with a man, woman or both?
- 11. Describe the best/worst boss you ever had.
- 12. How do you solve problems encountered at work?
- 13. Tell me about a failure in your life and tell me why it occurred?
- 14. What experience do you have cooking?
- 15. What kind of housework have you done in the past? Was it part of the job responsibility?
- 16. How comfortable are you with animals (pets, service animals)?
- 16a. Would you mind taking care of my pet(s)/service animal(s) feeding, walking, bathing, letting outside/inside?
- 17. Who is your best friend and how would you describe your friendship?
- 18. May I contact your professional references? I need the name, address and phone number of your last four employers. If your past personal care attendant job was not one of your last four jobs, may I have that employer's information also?
- 19. May I have a telephone number that I can reach you at?
- 20. Who should I call for you in case of an emergency? What is their number? What is their relation to you?
- 21. Do you have a valid driver's license? Can you provide me with a copy of your driver's license?
- 21a. What experience do you have driving accessible vans?
- 21b. Would you be comfortable driving me in my car to doctor's appointments, work, store, etc.?
- 22. Why do you want this job?
- 23. Why do you think that you are suited for this job?
- 24. What are some of the things your last employer could have done to keep you?
- 25. What questions do you have for me?

Questions to Consider When Hiring A Live-in Personal Care Attendant

- 26. Are you currently in a relationship?
- 26a. How does your partner feel about you applying for this job?
- 26b. What effect might this have on your relationship?
- 27. Do you expect to have any overnight guests?
- 28. How comfortable are you with my partner spending the night?
- 29. Would you have a problem getting up in the middle of the night if I needed help?
- 30. Do you have children? What are their ages? Do they live with you?
- 31. How much furniture would you have to move in?
- 32. How often do you smoke, use drugs, or drink alcohol?
